1 Teleconsultation

2 The patient reports to the clinic:

- alone
 - with the least possible number of personal belongings
- 

3 The patient calls when he or she is ready to enter the clinic



4 Put on your surgical mask*



5 You must open the doors



6 The patient puts down his or her personal belongings

7 The patient puts on a surgical mask



8 The patient washes his or her hands



9 Wash your hands and put on your personal protective clothing and glasses



10 Administer treatments while speaking as little as possible



11 The patient washes his or her hands and goes back to the reception area



12 Remove your personal protective clothing and glasses

13 Wash your hands



14 Provide instructions regarding follow-up and recommendations, while maintaining physical distancing of 2 m



15 Proceed with the payment transaction using:

- a contactless payment terminal
- automatic transfer



16 The patient retrieves his or her personal belongings, and removes and discards his or her mask



17 You must open the doors for the patient



18 Disinfect the door handles and treatment room



19 Wash your hands



*You can reuse the same surgical mask, provided it is not soiled or wet.
